

SAFETY WHILE TRAVELING

Safety and Security are of the utmost concern, so be aware of these issues and report any suspicious activities. THESE GUIDELINES ARE SUGGESTED TO ENSURE THE SAFETY AND SECURITY OF INDIVIDUALS

1. No drugs, alcohol, gambling or smoking will be tolerated at any time.
2. Upon checking into your room, locate the closest emergency exit and memorize its location. Also establish an alternate exit. Find out where the exit stairs lead. Never use the elevator during an emergency. An outdoor location to meet should be identified by the chaperone and roll call taken.
3. Avoid displaying large amounts of cash or expensive jewelry. Keep a small amount of cash in your pocket to pay for smaller purchases to avoid displaying cash in busy places.
4. For your protection, **always remain in groups of three or more.**
5. Individuals are held responsible for consequences in breaking any Federal, State, and/or local law or ordinance.
6. Keep your itinerary and contact information of your leader with you at all times.
