Lutheran World Relief has published a new pamphlet describing their quilts and kits for 2011. There are major changes. These booklets have been distributed at the Spring Cluster Events, but you can also access the information at www.lwr.org/beinvolved.

The names of some of the kits have changed as well. If you have left over items, you can continue to make up kits according to the 2008-2010 brochure as long as you mark the outside of the packing boxes "2010". Any kits made with the new requirements should be packed in boxes clearly labeled "2011" on the outside.

Do not pack 2010 kits with 2011 kits in the same box.
