CONSIDER BEING A DELEGATE TO OUR 2014 TRIENNIAL

We will be electing six delegates during our June 15, 2013 convention, who will represent our synod at the Triennial being planned for Charlotte, NC July 22-24, 2014. The Triennial Convention is the highest legislative authority of Women of the ELCA. As a delegate you will represent all the women in our synod and cast votes on their behalf. Actions taken will shape the future of our organization. This is a great responsibility!

You are expected to be at all convention business meetings, where you will:

- Be attentive to discussion on issues that require a vote.
- Help set the budget.
- Elect the executive board and officers who will carry on the business of the organization between conventions.
- Hear committee reports and vote on their recommendations.

Prior to the convention, you will receive the convention program and reports. You will need to read through the materials so you can arrive prepared to thoughtfully vote on the issues.

Churchwide will be responsible for your transportation, most meals and room (shared with another delegate from your synod). Most stay at their own expense for the Gathering that follows, but your responsibility ends when the business meetings are over. Priority will be given to women of color, those whose primary language is other than English and women who have not previously served as a delegate.

I have been a delegate to the convention in San Antonio ('05) and led our delegation as synod president in Spokane ('11). It helped me gain an appreciation for churchwide and its leadership, along with an awareness of all the ways we are serving our Lord throughout the world. It is also a great way to get acquainted with women from around the synod. Talk to the women who represented us in Spokane—Cecil Maureen Johnson, Cindy Pogge, Marjorie Lewis, Carol Burnikel, Andrea Wrage, Cheryl Moore, Anna Jetson, Syd Brinkman and myself. Can you sew?

Do you have fabric scraps tucked away, waiting for the perfect project? I am looking for some volunteers to assist me with making the item for the Triennial Delegates to trade at the Triennial Convention in Charlotte, NC. I have designed a simple coaster to make using 2 or 3 different fabrics. The front is a "pinwheel" representing the Wind Energy Windmills in NE Iowa. The back is one piece and will identify our synod as NE Iowa Synod. Finished size is 4 ½". The goal is to have between 400 and 500 by July 2014. Which is a bit of an undertaking, but if we break it down. If there are 20 volunteers, that would be 25 per person, but if there are 50 volunteers it would only be 10 per person, and if there are 100 volunteers it would only be five per person. Or, one person in each congregation could make 5. If you are willing to make some, please let me know how many you are willing to make. This is what the front should look like:
