 - Almost Christian by: Dean, Kenda Creasy
 - We pass on the faith from generation to generation
 - The faith gets weaker and weaker throughout each generation
 - When times are tough, god is there and he is great but when times are great god is eh!
 - The kind of faith we have taught teenagers
 - Church is the problem but also the solution
 - Not give up on teenagers
 - Change the way we pass on the faith to teenagers
 - Not just teaching by seeing

- Intentional effort to talk about who god is...deeper knowledge
- Done in community where people care about this and willing to share
- Congregations can nurture ways community programming can not
 - You grew up around them so people know you and encourage/support her in a way people who you just meet cant know you
- Relationships are absolutely key to pass on the faith
- Don't teach the "feel good, YAY god"
- Teach the risk faith.
 - Challenges you to go above and beyond
 - Serve everybody even the homeless like Jesus said to do
 - ◆ You can do this in your hallway at school, we are called to love these people, people who go across the grain and aren't popular
 - We need to pass along this faith
 - We have to be ok to teach it and encourage it but first we individually need to accept it
- Church has to change-current new theory
- ❖ Discussion on book and the churches new theory
 - How can we change the church? How can we help the kids in church stay after confirmation? How can we get kids to come on a regular basis? Why are we wasting our time trying to get people to come who won't?
 - Can't be seen as a program
 - DNA shift, congregations have been set in their ways
 - Change starts with people who just do it!
 - Adults have to be willing to get outside the box of programs and get into relationships
 - We (your congregation) have to provide something you cant get anywhere else
 - Youth workers are not the magic fix all
 - Youth workers need to help the congregation be youth workers themselves
 - They lead the congregation to help the youth and support them
 - Youth workers can only handle so many kids so maybe get more youth workers
 - Have 6-7 teams and just create things for them to do and get involved with the church
 - Push students beyond what their faith is.
 - Youth should feel welcome
 - Youth need to feel important
 - ◆ need to feel like they are an important part of something important
 - youth should feel as if people would be sad they didn't go to church
 - youth need to feel like they are special
 - Would it be beneficial to the youth if we asked the congregation to help us in our walk with faith or to be a little bit more involved?
 - Explain what you mean
 - No bible study like encourage
 - Lead the adults into what you need to be helped with
 - Be backwards, things you want them to do for you...you do for them

- ◆ Encourage them like you need to be encouraged
- ◆ Take the first step
- Adults need to relate to the kids and spread their knowledge to each kid
 - Adults tell stories during the trip about their faith and how they trust in God

Book talk: Deb Bachman Almost Christian- Kenda Dean

- Book about teens in faith.

Faith is passed on from generation to generation. Faith starts in the home. "When times are tough God is there and it's great but when times are good we don't care about God." What teens for the most part have been taught. We have to change the way faith is passed on. Faith won't be picked up by watching people. A deeper knowledge of good must be taught by a community who cares about the person. Specific congregations can encourage and support a child better than outside community events, because they have known that person and have more invested in them. Relationships are key in passing on the faith. Need to teach the faith that has risks, causes you to step out of comfort zone. Being a Christian should not be an easy job. Stop and serve people. Go to the outsiders, love them!! Church has to change.

Discussion:

How do we change?

Confirmation doesn't work! We have to evolve, change the DNA. Confirmation serves as a base of knowledge but it must include relationship building. Youth can go to congregation but they have to be specific. Starts with individuals who take time to invest in students. Adults have to be invested in children and build relationships.

How do we get people to stay?

We must change the way we do things

Youth directors have to be leaders and equip others in the church to help to nurture the children. They can truly invest themselves in a small group of kids as well.
