150 Women of the ELCA representing 60 of the congregations in our synod attended our three "Pep Rallies" at three different locations this past week. I want to thank the women of Our Savior's in Osage, Nazareth in Cedar Falls and St. James in Allison for doing such a great job of hosting these fall events.

Women who attended the Eighth Triennial of the Women of the ELCA shared the highlights of the convention and gathering held last July in Spokane, WA. As a synod board, we hope each woman attending went home with new information on programs ready to use that have been developed by our staff at churchwide. (Look for them on their website.)

Women from Nazareth demonstrated how they are making the new schoolbags and shared other tips for assembling the LWR kits as economically as possible. Ways of promoting the ELCA Campaign to eradicate malaria were presented and our offerings at the three rallies came to \$818! That should buy 82 mosquito nets which will protect young children in Africa who are dying at a rate of one child every 45 seconds there from malaria. Thanks to all for your generous giving.

Round table discussions gave participants the opportunity to share ideas and concerns from their home congregations. We sang joyful songs together and enjoyed the fellowship of other Lutheran women from around the synod. We hope to see even more of you next year!
