The Northeastern Iowa Synod of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA) will be hosting a visitor from Hungary, Pastor Erzsébet Molnár, from May 30 - June 15. She is the director of the Roma College, a college of the Lutheran Church, which is not a degree granting institution, but rather a residential college that provides support, cultural education, etc for Roma students attending the university. The Roma face incredible discrimination and poverty in Europe - which is one of the reasons that the ELCA has so many Young Adults in Global Mission (YAGMs) working in ministries that support Roma families.

During her visit Pastor Molnar will be meeting with people responsible for helping minority populations integrate in academic institutions at Wartburg College, the University of Northern Iowa, Augsburg College, and College Possible in Minneapolis as well as people who work in civil rights in the Department of Human Services in Des Moines. She will also be preaching at Trinity in Mason City, offering workshops at Synod Assembly, participating in WIYLDE, and meeting with the Companion Synod for Hungary Network.
